Material Declarations Statement

Many of Switching Power Inc.'s customers are requesting information regarding the presence or absence of hazardous and other materials in SPI products. Many times these requests are in the form of Material Declarations. It appears that customers seek this information in order to have a greater degree of assurance that SPI products comply with the RoHS directive and/or other legislation. Currently SPI is taking orders for RoHS-5 (NIE exemption) compliant and RoHS-6 compliant supplies. It is SPI's goal to provide products that comply with RoHS and other applicable laws.

As there is currently no legislation or industry standard that requires a Material Declaration or defines what a Material Declaration should include, SPI is facing a tremendous number of inconsistent demands from customers in terms of scope, content, type, and format for material disclosure. While the broad scope and sheer number of products supplied by SPI makes responding to all of these unique requests in a timely manner impossible at present, SPI is working towards a solution to provide Material Declarations.
